

CHAPTER EIGHT

PARKS AND PARK DISTRICT

ARTICLE 1 - Name, Powers and Jurisdiction

8.0101 Name and Creation

The City has heretofore accepted and taken advantage of the provisions of Section 40-49 of the North Dakota Century Code, and pursuant to said Section 40-49, heretofore created a park district for the City which shall be known as the "Park District of the City of New England."

8.0102 Powers

The park district shall have a seal and perpetual succession and may:

1. Sue and be sued.
2. Contract and be contracted with.
3. Acquire by purchase, gift, devise, or otherwise, and hold, own, possess, and maintain real and personal property in trust in use of parks, boulevards, and ways.
4. Exercise all the powers designated in Chapter 40-49 of the North Dakota Century Code, as amended.

8.0102 Jurisdiction

The Park District of the City of New England shall embrace all territory in the City as well as within any park or public ground which may be acquired outside the corporate limits of the City under the provisions of Section 40-49 of the North Dakota Century Code.

ARTICLE 2 - Park Board

8.0201 Powers and Members

The powers of the park district shall be exercised by a board of park commissioners consisting of five (5) members who shall have such duties and powers as defined by Chapter 40-49 of the North Dakota Century Code.

8.0202 Board Elections and Governance

Members of the Park Board shall be elected according to the terms of Section 40-49-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, and amendments thereto. The Park Board shall exercise its powers by ordinance as provided in Section 40-49-13 of the North Dakota Century Code and amendments thereto, and as otherwise provided in Chapter 40-49 of the North Dakota Century Code.

8.0203 Park Regulations

All property under the jurisdiction of the Park Board shall be managed and regulated by such rules and regulations as the Park Board may enact.
